Tar Hollow State Park September 29- October 1



Everyone who is part of our church family is invited to the campout! Tar Hollow is located in the Hocking Hills region, approximately 1½ hours from Plain City. We have reserved the private group area with a large lodge, our own access to the lake with boats, kayaks and fishing and swimming.



Cost:

\$25/ person (children 2 and under are free)

Family Rate: \$60 (for parents and children living in the household)

Saturday only with no overnight lodging: \$15/ person



Lodging Options:

-tent camping (non-electric)

-RV camping (10 hookups available)

-hillside cabins (4 bunk beds per cabin with shared restroom/shower house)

-3 lower level cabins with attached restrooms (seniors will have priority)
